Day 1: Helsinki

Helsinki, Finland's southern capital, sits on a peninsula in the Gulf of Finland. Upon arrival we will visit – **Suomenlinna** (UNESCO's World Heritage) - is an 18th-century sea fortress and nature area with centuries-old artillery and defensive walls, spread across 6 linked islands. Take a ferry ride to visit this unique place. Later drive back and hotel check-in followed by dinner. Overnight in Helsinki.

Day 2: Helsinki – Stockholm by Cruise

Check out and proceed to **Guided city tour** of Helsinki. See Senate Square, the Lutheran Temppeliaukio Church or ‘Rocky church of Helsinki’, which is quarried out of natural bedrock, the Uspenski Cathedral, the marvelous Sibelius Park, the Presidential Palace, Finland a Hall, the Opera House, and many more interesting sights. Later, board your luxury cruise. Cruise across the Baltic Sea and through the Swedish archipelago to Stockholm.

Overnight on a luxury cruise.

Day 3: Stockholm

Today, visit the famous **Vasa Museum**, housing the majestic 17th century royal warship Vasa. Later visit **Drottningholm Palace**, a former royal summer residence, the home of the Swedish Royal family and a UNESCO World Heritage site. Overnight in Stockholm.

Day 4: Stockholm

Today, visit Skansen Park, an open-air museum and zoo spread over 75 acres. Later proceed for a Guided city tour - **City Hall**, Royal Palace, the Cathedral, the Old Town, Kings Garden, and many more interesting sights. Later, **Ride the Sky View** – a new world-class attraction that takes you on a breathtaking journey, along the outside, to the top of the world’s largest spherical building, the Ericsson Globe, a Stockholm landmark. Overnight in Stockholm. Later you can visit the **Ice Bar** (inside visit not included). Overnight in Stockholm.

Day 5: Stockholm – Oslo

Early morning proceed to Oslo (approx. 7 hrs. drive). Upon arrival, proceed for a guided city tour – Visit the majestic Akershus fortress or Akershus Castle, a medieval castle built to protect Oslo, the capital of Norway. It has also been used as a palace and as a prison. Later Visit Karl Johan Street. Overnight in Oslo.

(Meals: B, L, D)

Day 6: Oslo – Geilo

Tour the Viking Ship Museum which presents ships from the Viking periods such as Gokstad, Oseberg, and Tune. Visit the unique **Vigeland Sculpture Park**. After lunch, proceed to Geilo (approx. 3.5 hrs. drive). Overnight in Geilo.

Day 7: Geilo – Bergen - Norway in Nutshell

Transfer to Geilo railway station. Take a train to Myrdal. Take the train to **Flam**. We cruise to Gudvangen one of Norway’s most famous and splendid Fjords called “Norway in Nutshell”. Meet the coach in Gudvangen and transfer to Bergen where we continue our journey. Overnight in Bergen.

Day 8: Bergen

Take a city tour of Bergen ‘the Gateway to the Fjords’ we pass through charming villages. Visit the **Harbor**, Next, take a fun-filled ride on the **Funicular train**, to the top of the mountain and enjoy the panoramic and uninterrupted views of the city and its surroundings. Overnight at Bergen.

Day 9: Bergen - Copenhagen

After breakfast, proceed to the airport to take a flight to Copenhagen. On Arrival We will visit the famous **Tivoli Gardens** - the second-oldest amusement park in the world. Overnight at Copenhagen.

Day 10: Copenhagen

Today, we proceed for a guided city tour of Scandinavia’s largest and liveliest metropolis- the city Hall, the Parliament building, the Amalienborg Palace, which is the home of the royal family, the Stock Exchange, Geffen fountain, the **Little Mermaid Statue**, and The Christiansburg. Later we will visit one of the most famous Danish beer makers – **Carlsberg Brewery**. Here you will learn about the brewing process, see the collection of over 21,000 beer bottles from all over the world and visit the stables with the “brewery horses”. and later in the afternoon will cruise along the canals of Copenhagen. Overnight in Copenhagen.

(Meals: B, L, D)

Day 11: Departure

After breakfast, we will proceed to the airport for the flight back home or your next destination is Iceland.

Extension of Iceland (Optional)

Day 11: Reykjavik (Iceland)

Today, on arrival Visit the Blue Lagoon, it’s situated within a 20 minutes’ drive from the airport. This famous geothermal spa is an amazing sight where you can relax by bathing in warm water surrounded by mysterious black lava fields. The Blue Lagoon’s warm water and natural active ingredients; mineral salts, silica, and blue-green algae help you relax and escape the stress and strain of daily life. After the spa visit, we will proceed to Reykjavik and Overnight in Reykjavik. (40 minutes’ drive). Overnight in Reykjavik.

(Meals: D)

Day 12: Reykjavik - The Golden Circle

Today visit Golden Circle; we start by driving to **Thingvellir National Park**. This is a historical area where the Icelandic Parliament was held for several centuries. It is also considered one of the world's geological wonders; at Thingvellir, you will witness the effects of the tectonic plate movements which opened various cracks and fissures in the earth's crust. After taking a walk in the unique landscape of Thingvellir, we continue to the famous geothermal area of Geysir. There the **Strokkur hot spring** ejects its water column high into the air every 5 – 10 minutes or so and numerous other small springs are boiling and bubbling. Then we only have a short drive to reach **Gullfoss**, a magnificent waterfall that Icelanders refer to as the "Golden" waterfall, surely one of the most beautiful in Iceland. Overnight in Vik / Jokulsarlon.

(Meals: B, L, D)

Day 13: South Coast

Today proceed to stop at **Black Sand Beach**. *Later cross Eldhraun, the largest mass of lava ever to flow on the face of the earth before reaching the Skaftafell National Park. Here you'll also start seeing the largest glacier in Iceland, the Vatnajökull that covers more than 8% of the island. Continue to the spectacular Jökulsárlón Glacial Lagoon and see the birthplace of icebergs. You'll even have the option to take a trip on an amphibian boat and get close to the icebergs for a different kind of view.* later we proceed to Vik, overnight in Vik/ Jökulsárlón.

(Meals: B, L, D)

Day 14: Vik to Reykjavik to Keflavik

Our final day has you retracing your steps on the way back to Reykjavik visit Skógafoss Falls after that Seljalandsfoss waterfall, this is a beautiful sixty-meter-high waterfall that you can walk behind and is a stunning photography opportunity. Easily one of the most impressive waterfalls in Iceland. Return to Reykjavik. Enjoy visit to Perlan Museum and Fly over Iceland. Overnight in Keflavik.

(Meals: B, L, D)

Day 15: Departure

Today after breakfast proceed to the airport to take your flight back home. **(Meals: B)**
